Jackson County Republican Women was founded in 1945, as an arm of the National Federation of Republican Women (NFRW) and the Oregon State Federation (OFRW). We are 69 years old this year.

Republican Women Clubs began to emerge in the later part of the 19th century. However the actual formation of the National Association of Republican Women was in 1938. At the time of the National Federation's formation, 3 states had not yet ratified the 19th amendment to the constitution granting suffrage to women. The Oregon Federation of Republican Women was founded in 1940.

The NFRW 100,000 members strong with local units in all 50 states plus the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam, and the Virgin Islands. The NFRW is one of the largest women's lobby in the Country. A women becomes a member by joining her local unit .

Our goals are to educate and provide a positive impact in the political arena. Not only in our County but in our State and our Nation. We support the ideals and the policies of the Republican Party on both the State and the National level.

We use our resources to:

- Train campaign leaders and volunteers
- Recruit and train women for public office and other leadership roles
- Educate members on legislative issues
- Educate our School Children on the Constitution and the Bill of rights.

We also send a High School Student to Girls State in Salem for 1 week every year and support programs for our Veterans. We collect food for our local Food Bank.

We have a Spring Fashion Show Fundraiser in the Spring and in the Fall we have a Reagan BBQ at the Handley Farm in Central Point.
